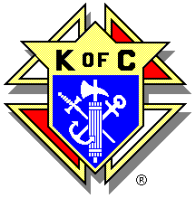

### From the State Deputy

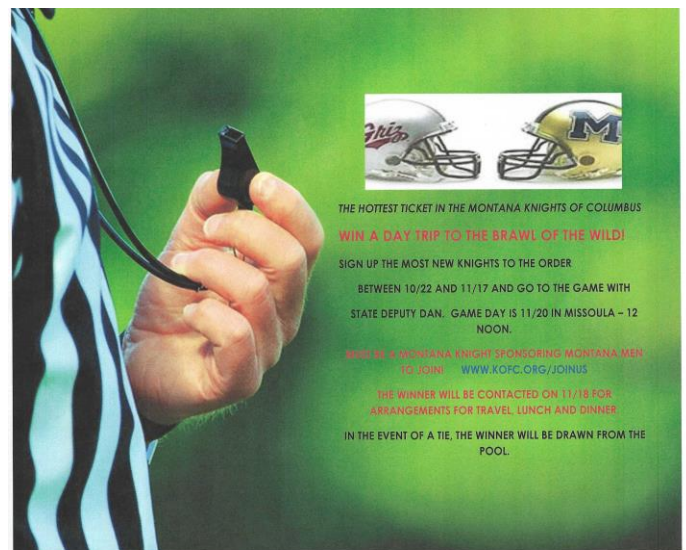

32 Council 9395 members and 6 Council 7726 Belt/Geyser.... 6 prepared a BBQ using their own portable grill on wheels, as pictured.

Approximately 250 attended. Besides time, talents and treasures, cool treats consisting of 400 various ice cream bars were enjoyed and 256 hours were spent preparing the BBQ meal, set-up, tear-down and clean-up.

#### Attractions Provided by Council:

A membership/Information booth was set up and manned by council Knights. Three recruits signed

up. The Council handed out prayer cards packets with ring Rosaries and *Our Lady of Guadalupe* lapel pens.

Yard games were set-up and operated by the Council for event goers. "*Corn hole*" and "*Rings in the Bucket*" tournaments in observance of the State Council's "*Corn Hole the COVID Council Challenge*" attracted 56 contestants.

In addition, a secondary "*Corn Hole the COVID Council Challenge*" with 26 competitors was successfully conducted at our council's annual summer BBQ and social event on Sept 25th at the Black Eagle Park,
